*A-G 4 YEAR COLLEGE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

English	4 years
Mathematics (Integrated 1, Int. 2, Int. 3)	3 years
Social Science (Wld. Hst., U.S. Hist. and/or Gov.)	2 years
Science with Lab (Biology, Chemistry or Physics)	2 years
Foreign Language (same language, prefer 3 years)	2 years
(or 1 semester College Foreign Language)	
Visual and performing arts (art, theatre, music)	1 year
Electives (additional years of: advanced math / social sci. / lab sci / foreign lang. / visual or perf. arts / psychology)	1 year

- Required tests may include ACT or SAT.
- Of the 15 required UC courses ("a-g"), students must complete 11 of those by the end of 11th grade.

Note - Some community college classes taken in High School can help meet A-G requirements, count as one year of high school credit, and honors credit for your GPA.
